Graduation Requirements

24 units of credit are required for graduation: 4 units of Theology, 4 units of English, 4 units of Mathematics, 3 units of Science, 3 units of Social Studies, 2 units of Foreign Language, 1 unit of Fine Arts, .5 units of Physical Education, .5 units of Health, .5 units of Personal Finance, and 1.5 units of Electives.

Grading scale is 4.0 with one-point weighted grading applied to AP classes only.

- * 65% of graduating seniors graduated with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better, with 41% earning above 3.5
- * Nearly 50% of underclassmen achieved Alpha Honor Roll for 2nd semester 2024, earning a 3.5 grade point average or better
- * Nearly 20% of underclassmen achieved Beta Honor Roll for 2nd semester 2024, earning a 3.0 to 3.49 grade point average

12 students took one or more AP tests at St. Philip in 2023. The passing rate for St. Philip in May 2023 was 61%
16 students took one or more AP tests at St. Philip in 2024. The passing rate for St. Philip in May 2024 was 38%
9 students took one or more AP tests at St. Philip in 2025. The passing rate for St. Philip in May 2025 was 67%

What makes St. Philip unique?

- * Saint Philip is located in downtown Battle Creek, Michigan
- * 21% of the student population are Asian, African American, or Bi-racial and 22% are Hispanic
- * 17% of the student population has a first language other than English
- * Saint Philip is a Catholic high school; all of our students take four years of Theology and students are required to complete a minimum of 20 hours of community service each year
- * Each year, each class attends a religious retreat; seniors go to Notre Dame
- * After graduation, seniors take a class trip to Rome
- * Students participate in a student-led mass every Tuesday and Friday
- * Saint Philip has many traditions, including that after every football game, students come back to the Grotto to pray
- * Almost all of our students participate in a Senior Internship
- * We have a 95% graduation rate, and most of our students are college or career-ready

Future Plans

- * 80% of graduating seniors attend college
- * 12% of graduating seniors enter a credentialing program
- * 6% of graduating seniors enter the military
