




GUIDED by FAITH, INSPIRED by FATHER FITZ

STP Building Renovation

The summer of 2025 marked an exciting new chapter for St. Philip High School as we completed a series of long-overdue renovations designed to enhance the daily experience for our students and staff. The project included a complete replacement of our aging HVAC system, bringing much-needed comfort and efficiency to classrooms year-round. To support this upgrade, the building also received new electrical systems, ensuring we could fully accommodate the demands of modern technology and climate control.

In addition, two of our science labs were completely transformed into state-of-the-art learning environments. These updated spaces now provide students with modern equipment, improved safety features, and flexible layouts that encourage collaboration and hands-on discovery. For our teachers, the new labs have opened the door to expanded lesson possibilities and cutting-edge instructional methods. We look forward to celebrating these updates with a special dedication ceremony in the fall of 2025.

St. Philip alum Bill Steele (Class of 1975) has played a leading role in bringing these renovations to life, generously dedicating his time to coordinating and guiding the many moving parts of the project. Reflecting on his involvement, Bill shared:

"The volunteer work that I'm doing is a small portion of what is involved in making this happen. The donors who are committed to a Catholic education in the Battle Creek area, the Foundation and care they've taken, the teachers, administration, the priests. It's a whole community. The credit goes to the (BCACS) community because they are committed to this. I think it's important that Battle Creek keeps a K-12 Catholic school going. When I saw this opportunity, I didn't think twice about what help I could bring to it. We always thought it was important that the school maintains a strong presence in this town."

These remarkable improvements were made possible through the extraordinary generosity of several longtime friends of our schools. Bill and Pat LaMothe, true forward thinkers, made a planned gift that placed them in our legacy giving circle, the Guardian Angel Guild, helping to bring these renovations to life. We are also deeply grateful to other contributors, including The Santo, Maria, Frank, and John Zanetti Foundation, whose thoughtful gifts made this project a reality. Together, their generosity reflects a shared belief in the mission of Catholic education and ensures that St. Philip will remain a place of faith-filled learning for generations to come.

St. Joseph Schools also recently celebrated an exciting upgrade with the installation of a brand-new gym floor. The gym has long been a hub of activity, hosting everything from P.E. classes and athletic practices to school assemblies and community events. After decades of use, the original floor had begun to show its age.

In recent years, the old surface required cleaning up to three times a day just to reduce the risk of slipping. While it carried the memories of countless games, events, and generations of students, it was clear that a safer and more reliable surface was needed.

The solution came in the form of a state-of-the-art Sport Court surface, installed directly over the existing floor. This modern flooring system offers significant improvements with better traction, shock absorption, and improved durability. Not only does the new gym floor enhance safety, but it also gives the space a fresh, updated look that reflects the energy and spirit of St. Joseph School.

This important project was made possible thanks to the generous contributions of our community to the BCACS Foundation. Your support ensures that our students benefit from safe, modern facilities that help them grow in body, mind, and spirit.


